Role Description:

With your help, VCF and Villa Charities can continue to provide cultural and educational programs and support culturally sensitive long-term care and independent living apartments for seniors.

Planning an event provides the perfect platform to share our message of enriching lives through experiences and services that honour Italian culture and heritage. Key duties include:

- 1. **Leading a Third-Party Event:** Generating funds in support of VCF by leading a third-party event. Promoting the event and generating interest within the community with a focus of appealing to young adults under the age of 35. The event idea/type can take any format but should include the opportunity for young adults to come together. Each Committee member is expected to lead or actively support in the planning, promotion, and organization of the event(s).
- 2. **Securing Sponsorships:** Generating and securing sponsorships from businesses and individuals in your network or who may have an affinity to Villa Charities or Villa Charities' mission. Soliciting sponsorships and providing an update during Committee meetings. Secure at least 1 sponsorship of \$1,000 or above.
- 3. **Promotion of Event**: Generating interest within the community and with young adults to attend the event. Promoting the event via different channels including word of mouth, social media and personal and corporate contacts if applicable. Providing updates on (i.e.) number of tickets sold, flagging gaps and challenges. Work in collaboration with Villa Charities on creation of all material to promote the event ensuring adherence to VC & VCF brand guidelines.

Expectations:

- Attendance at quarterly virtual committee meetings
- Work in partnership with VCI Board Chair, VCF Director of Development, VCF Fundraising Specialist
- Work with Next Gen Leaders Committee members to promote/support event within a personal and professional network and surrounding community
